

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

MAY 9, 2026

The Ladoga Town Council met on May 9, 2026, in the Ladoga Town Hall at 9:00 AM for a Regular Council meeting. Present were Council President; Mike Hubble; Councilmember; Ronald Brown; Councilmember; Tricia Garcia; Clerk Treasurer; Amy Holladay; Deputy Clerk; April Bradley; Town Employee; Justin Miller. Town Employee; Donnie Long; Town Employee; Dwayne Scott; Town Marshal; Mike Hunley; Town Attorney; Dave Peebles. and Town Engineer Ken Smith were not present. Citizens present: Trent Lowe, Jay Prosser, Megan Noggle, Daryl Holt, Tod Powers, Jack Elless, Kendra Jones and Anthony Richards.

Mike Hubble called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Mike asked for any corrections to the April 29th Regular Council meeting minutes as written. Hearing none, Mike called for a motion to approve the April 29th Regular Council meeting minutes. Ronald made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; motion was seconded by Mike; motion passed. Ayes-3. Mike called for a motion to approve the Claim Docket; Mike made a motion to approve the Claim Docket; motion was seconded by Tricia motion passed. Ayes-3.

PUBLIC CONCERNS: **Megan Noggle/Librarian** asked for permission to close a portion of Franklin St. on June 1st for a street fair. Ronald made a motion to allow the closure; motion was seconded by Mike; motion passed. Ayes-3. Megan also noted that the library is going to be building on an addition and urged the public to complete the survey to help with obtaining a grant. The library received a grant from Wabash College and purchased a 3-D printer. The printer is for library staff use only at this time but will soon be open to the public. **Kendra Jones/3B2G Properties** gave the Council an update on the Unsafe Building Order for 111 N. Washington St. She noted that the owner is working on a new building permit and cannot move forward with any renovation until the permit goes through. She noted that the owner does have liability insurance. She will keep the Council updated on the progress. **Tod Powers** asked the Council if the alley on the west side of his property could be closed during the construction/closure on SR234. Tricia made a motion to temporarily close the alley during construction; motion was seconded by Mike; motion passed. Ayes-3. **Anthony Richards** noted that the street at the corner of Messick and South is in bad shape. He also noted that the trees need to be trimmed in that area also. Council will check the area after the water line movement in June.

OLD BUSINESS: SIDEWALKS ON SOUTH, MERIDIAN AND SYCAMORE ST: This item was tabled until the town employees can get quotes.

NEW BUSINESS: APPROVAL OF PAYMENT FOR COMMUNITY CROSSINGS GRANT: Amy noted that the paving project was complete and she needed permission to pay the invoice. Tricia made a motion to approve payment; motion was seconded by Mike; motion passed. Ayes-3.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO BE BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD:

CLERK TREASURER: Amy noted that Ron Gibson had spoken with her about the alley south of his property at 122 N. Sycamore. The Town had replaced a water line in the alley and cars had driven on Ron's property to avoid the construction. Ron would like the Town to re-route the ally to get it off his property. Council noted that Ron will need to get the property surveyed to find the exact property line. Amy also noted that she will be working on the budget for 2027 soon.

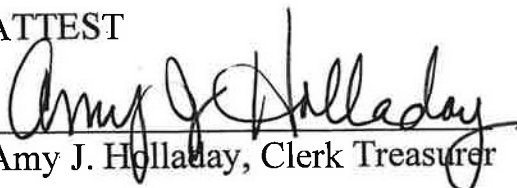
DEPUTY CLERK: April noted that she had submitted the legal ad for the planning grant.

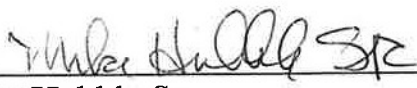
Tricia made a motion to adjourn the meeting; the motion was seconded by Ronald; motion passed; Ayes-3.
